

Rail Cut Shot Aiming and CB Control

Positions A, B: Aim the shot as normal, as if the cushion were not there.

<u>Position C</u>: Aim for a cushion-first hit with running english (allows softer speed, makes shot easier). Aim closer to the ball with slower speed and steeper angles into the cushion.



- 1. Ball-first hits (or ball-cushion-at-the-same-time hits) are required with both CB paths, allowing the english to "take" on the cushion after the hit.
- 2. With a cushion-first hit, the CB would come off the rail close to the tangent line.
- 3. Due to throw, the inside english shot (the blue/light path) requires a hit closer to the cushion.
